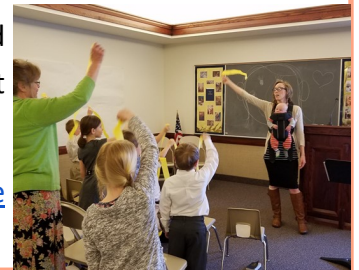

Crepe Paper & Chalk

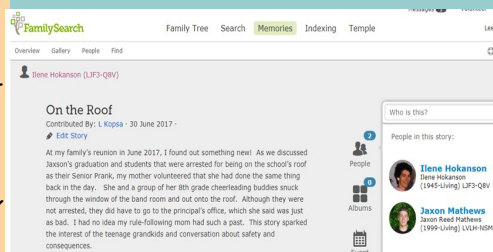
The children were fascinated and loved following Sister Armitsteadt as she taught a song using crepe paper and chalk.
